HOW TO SHARE THE HISTORICAL FULFILLMENT OF PROPHECY

The enemy misleads most people with the futuristic explanations of the 70th week of Daniel 9 and Revelation. It's been programmed into their minds through repetition from pastors, books, videos, websites, and study Bibles. If you give them a book or website with the historicist view, they'll probably reject it.

Some people have become experts at explaining the false script of a future 70th week of Daniel, which is started by a one-man antichrist making a peace agreement, 3 ½ years of relative peace, then the antichrist will enter a rebuilt Jewish temple and proclaim to be God and demand that people bow to his authority. They believe that most of Revelation will be fulfilled during the last 3 ½ years, and they cite many verses to defend their beliefs.

If you tell them that they're wrong and have been deceived, they will defend their beliefs. People don't want to learn that they've been misled by their pastors, parents, etc. Most will resist learning the truth from you, as you've not been to Bible college, and they blindly trust pastors who have been.

If you think you need to explain prophecy fulfillment to them, it can cause you not to try because it can be intimidating as people can be very aggressive in rejecting truth and you. Here's how I recommend sharing the truth to let them determine their path and learn the fulfillment for themselves.

Your role is not to be an expert but to share summaries to potentially open their eyes so that they move forward to get more information. You want to create curiosity and doubt in their mind so that they may pursue more information. This allows them to learn it for themselves.

The enemy's futuristic script of the fulfillment of Revelation is based on the concept of a futuristic 70th week of Daniel 9, so that's the best starting point. Share the one-page summary PDF that can be found on the home page of the website: <u>www.70thweekofdaniel.com</u>

You can save the PDF, email it to them or print it out for them. They can ignore the email, so if possible, give them the printed explanation. Then pray that the Spirit moves in their life to show them the truth.

The one-page summary lists the website, so they can go to the home page and follow the path of learning if they want more information. If they ask you for more info, give them a link to the videos about the 70th week of Daniel 9. Or you can suggest that they request a free copy of the PDF of the book or order a printed book.

If they reject the explanations in the summary, there's no use in giving them more information, and the harder you press, the more you cause them to defend their beliefs. Let it go and pray for them. This method is more attractive to them, as you're not pushing them, and they may circle back later for more information.

When they understand that the 70th week of Daniel 9 is about Messiah, not about the end times or the antichrist, they can see that the futuristic explanation of Revelation is based on a faulty foundation.
